The ~~Committee~~ revision of the prize list for Hattle Sheep Swine &c was considered when the following alterations were made

Class H Short Horns Section 1 prizes £5. + £2 Section 2 £5 + 2
Section 3 £7 + £3 Section 4 £4 + £2 Section 5 £5 + £2 Section
6 £4. 2. Sec 7 £4. £2 Section 8 £3. + 1

Classes were added for Tipperary + Polled Angus cattle prizes to be withheld unless 3 compete as were also the prizes for Channel Island Cattle

Demant Farmer class for Dairy Cattle prizes increased to £10. £5 the Sheep Sections in the class were divided into sections for long woolled + short woolled sheep prizes being offered for the best ram of any age for the best pen of 5 shearing ewes for the best pen of 5 live lambs + for the best pen of 5 lam lambs in each

A section for the best pen of Ram lambs was added to the Long woolled + short woolled classes for sheep

Swine - the Swine were divided into three varieties 3 prizes being given in each - viz Large white Yorkshire, Any other pure distinct white breed, + Any other other coloured breed.

Secretary read letter from M Parker Sec B. Irish Pig Breeders association offering two sets of medals + £3. £2. £1 for the best boar under 12 months old
