

Meeting of Finance Committee held
Saturday Feb 25. 1905.

Mr G. Heard in the chair also present Messrs
L. A. Beames and J. Dering

The minutes of last meeting were read and
signed.

On the motion of Mr Beames, seconded by Mr
Dering it was decided to recommend cheques to be drawn
for £10 each in favor of 18 shareholders, on the understand-
ing that they were to be repaid to the Society in accordance
with Messrs Beames instructions. It was
decided to tender a cheque. Mr Heard mentioned he
would see Mr J. Donovan in regard to his shares.

Quotations were received as follows for 5 x 4 o.g.
shook. Haughton 2/10; Perry 3/; Scott 2/7.

After a discussion it was eventually decided
to select 5" half round shook and that they be
put up on shed in front of new box stalls and
also on shed at the Northern side of quadrangle.

It was decided to accept Messrs Perry's tender at
1/22 per length and it was also decided to give them
the order for down pipes at 1/9 and stops at 2 3/4 each.

It was decided to report to Messrs Harrington that
the red oxide paint manufactured by them and put on
the roofs of buildings had scaled off in several
patches and to apply for 5 galls to renew such patches.

It was agreed to procure estimates for 10 galls
red paint for painting the outside woodwork of
buildings.

It was decided to ask the Manager of the G. B. &
P. R. to submit a definite proposal as to conditions under
which a platform would be erected at ground.

It was decided to plant 100 trees (Sycamores or lms)
to replace dead trees.
