CLASS

:—"That all members who have not paid their subscriptions due on the 1st January on or before the 1st August in each year shall be posted in the committee room of the society for one month commencing the 1st day of August; and all those whose subscriptions for the current year are not paid by the 1st September in each year shall cease to be members of the society; but the rule shall not apply to members elected after the society's show whose subscription shall become payable in the following year.
