Minutes of former meetings were read and confirmed.

Mr. Geo. Walter^{son} Crosshaven, having been Proposed by Mr. J. Heid, and Seconded by Mr. J. Reid at former meeting was elected unanimously a Member of the Society.

Read letter of 2nd April from Shorthorn Society of Great Britain & Ireland enclosing copy of Resolution with reference to Railway Rates and Special Wagon for conveying valuable Stock to Show &c. Referred to Show Sub-Committee.

Read letter of 21st April from G. S. Holster, Eleutheron, Kanturk, stating that as Mr. Gallie's Sire "Prescription" was not standing for Service in Kometer having won 1st Prize at Society's Show in 1886, according to the conditions, he claimed the 1st Prize.
