Secretary read letter from Royal Dublin Society asking the Society to undertake the distribution of the success premiums for Stallion allocated to the South of Ireland after some discussion the matter was referred to the General Committee the Shaw Committee not being competent to give an undertaking on behalf of the Society

It was decided to reserve 72 seats on the jumping stand for which a charge of 5/- each would be made

Mr H S Druif Col Shuldham & Mr R H Beamish were appointed stewards of the stand

Mr J Donovan announced that the Imperial Hotel Co Ltd had kindly given a Challenge Cup value £25 for the best 4 year old in the show to be won twice before it became the property of winner

Secretary read letter from Mr McKenzie stating that as he was an exhibitor he could not act as Steward of Butcher

The question of complimentary tickets was under consideration and after some discussion the Secretary was it was decided to give the same as last year with the exception of the 70 given to the Trustees in lieu of which the Secretary was directed to give 25 to the Committee of Management whose names the Secretary was directed to get from the Town Clerk
