 judges in Ring no. 2, and the Yearlings and three-year-olds in no. 1 Ring.

In connection with the Sloop Dog trial, the Secretary was directed
 to write and ask Mr. Woss of Cahingrove if he would be able to
 provide some sleep for this purpose.

It was decided to call the new Box stalls the "Presentation Box
 Stalls", and the Secretary was directed to allocate Boxes as follows:-
 Brood Mares, Yearlings, 1st two-year-olds to get first preference,
 and the remainder to be divided between those who has herbed stalls.
