Recommendation from Horticultural Committee.

A recommendation was received from the Horticultural Committee that the Hon. Mrs. Bell, Fota Island, Cobh, and Mrs. E.J. Clarke, Aghamarta Castle, Carrigaline, be co-opted on the Horticultural Committee to fill the vacancies caused by the resignation of Mrs. Purvis and Mrs. S. H. Dring, and, on the motion of Mr. T. O'Sullivan, seconded by Mr. A.H. Moore, the recommendation of the Horticultural Committee was unanimously adopted.

Resolution re the supplying of Coal.

A discussion took place on the question of coal for threshing purposes, and it was unanimously decided to forward the following resolution to the Minister for Supplies; on the motion of Mr. A. Mullins, seconded by Mr. D. Cronin and supported by Mr. E. Wall:-

" That we request the Minister for Supplies to release Coal from reserved stocks to the farmers for threshing purposes; distribution to be on the basis of the acreage of grain grown by each farmer."
