The Minutes of the last meeting were read and signed.

Death of the late Ald. W. Desmond.

Votes of Sympathy to relatives of Ald. W. Desmond and S.R. Lysaght. The President said that since their last meeting the Society had lost a valued member in the death of Ald. Desmond, who had been a very active member of the Show Committee for over twenty years, and in other capacities he proved himself equally active. Ald. Willie Desmond, the President continued, had played many parts in the life of the City, and his death was exceedingly regretted. He (the President) moved a vote of sympathy to his widow and relatives. Mr. J. Daly, V.S., in seconding the motion, said that Ald. Desmond's death was a serious loss to the Society.
