Retiring Members on Finance Committee, who are eligible for re-election:

In accordance with the rules of the Society, the three members who have the least number of attendances on the Finance Committee retire but are eligible for re-election. The three retiring Members were:- Messrs P.J. Good, J. Lehane & E. Wall. There was also a fourth vacancy caused through the resignation of Mr. A.H. Good from the General Committee, and, on the motion of Mr. T. O'Sullivan, seconded by Mr. T. O'Leary, the three outgoing members were unanimously re-elected.

Date of Summer Show:

On the motion of Mr. A.H. Moore, seconded by Mr. T. O'Sullivan, Mr. M.D. Hosford was unanimously elected to fill the fourth vacancy.  
The President stated that the Show Committee had been considering the question of the dates of the Summer Show for this year and had gone into the matter very fully, and it was agreed that it would be far better to have only a one day's Show. It was decided to fix Wednesday, 21st June, as the most suitable date. The original dates fixed for the Show were the 28th & 29th June, but one of these dates, in the opinion of the Show Committee, would not be suitable for a one day's Show. After discussing the matter, the Committee agreed with the Show Committee's decision, and approved of the date of the Summer Show, viz:- 21st June.
