The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and signed.

A letter was read from the Hunters' Improvement Society stating they were unable to recommend any Judge of horses, owing to a number of their members being in the Forces, and in view of transport difficulties, they suggested getting Judges nearer home. This was noted, and the question of selecting Judges was left in the hands of the President and Secretary.
