Show Committee:

Meeting of the Show Committee held on Saturday, 27th October, 1945, Mr. E. J. Clarke, President, in the Chair, also present Messrs P. O'Sullivan, M. Hayes, E. Wall, J. B. Roberts, J. S. Henderson, M. D. Hoeford, P. O'Leary. X

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and signed.

Mr. P. O'Sullivan stated that his attention had been drawn to the fact that the Judge appointed for Shorthorns at the late Summer Show adjudicated with the Hereford Judge in the Hereford Ring, and that, apparently, the Hereford Judge then, during the judging of the Shorthorns, adjudicated with the Shorthorn Judge. He (Mr. O'Sullivan) stated that he would like to know if permission had been given to these Judges to judge breeds other than those they were appointed to judge, to which the Secretary replied in the negative. After a discussion, it was decided that such an occurrence be not allowed again, and, arising out of this, Mr. E. Wall suggested that a code should be laid down for the Stewards to work on during the days of the Show. It was agreed that the Secretary should look up the rules and regulations of Shows of the Society, and the instructions to Judges and Stewards, and to have prepared from these a code for the Stewards to work on.
