Cheques:Recommendation from Finance Committee re Rules of Society:

A recommendation from the Finance Committee was then & considered, viz:- that rule 7 of the Society's Rules & Regulations, which at present reads - "The minimum subscription is £1, except in the case of bona fide farmers (and the sons of farmers) whose valuation is less than £50, and whose principal source of income comes from farming, when the minimum subscription is 10/-, being due on the 1st January of the year. The minimum subscription for members of the Squash Rackets section is £1. 10. 0; and the dues section 10/6d, both the above to be subject to variation by the General Committee on the recommendation of the Show and Finance Committees. Members proposed and elected after the Society's Summer Show shall not be liable for any subscription until the following year. This does not apply to members of the Squash Rackets section, whose subscription is due on the 1st September each year."
