

Meeting of the Dog Show Committee held on Thursday, February 10, 1949. In the absence of the Chairman Mr. J.S.H. Dring was moved to the chair, also present Mrs. K. Dalton, Miss M.E. McCulloch, and Mr. T.G. Kirby.

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and signed.

A letter was read from Mr. H. Calvert, stating that he would be pleased to act as All Round Judge at the forthcoming Show at an inclusive fee of 15 guineas, and it was agreed to accept Mr. Calvert's offer.

A letter was also read from Mr. A.J. Edwards, stating that he would not name a fee, as he was not used to being put on a competitive basis when the question of fees and expenses arose. The Secretary was instructed to write to Mr. Edwards, informing him that the Committee had no intention of putting him in competition with others on the basis as to which of them would be the cheapest, but it was necessary for the Committee to budget for their expenses previous to the Show; hence their reason for asking him for an inclusive fee. The Committee would be prepared to accept him as a Judge, if his inclusive fee did not exceed 15 guineas.

The classification was then gone into by the Committee, and a large number of breeds were taken out of the schedule, viz:- Wire Haired Dachshunds; Greyhounds; English Setters; Irish Water Spaniels; Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers; Boxers; Dalmatians, and a number of classes for other breeds were considerably reduced by amalgamating the dog and bitch classes.

The Committee, on request, decided to include classes for the following breeds:-

Basenjis; Poodles (Miniature); Elkhounds & Boston Terriers.
