

Suggestion re Tea Room at Summer Show:

In connection with the forthcoming Summer Show, Mr. T.N. Desmond suggested that, if it would be possible, a Tea Room should be provided for exhibitors. It was explained to Mr. Desmond that covered accommodation was not available for this, and it was decided that the Secretary should make representation to the Caterers, inquiring if they could make refreshments available in the Tent in the Jumping Enclosure from 11.30 a.m.

Recommendation re having a Mineral Bar

Regarding the accommodation in the Bar, it was decided to recommend to the Show Committee that a Tent be provided for the supplying of minerals. Mr. E. Wall, who made the suggestion, said that this would relieve the congestion in the Bar a good deal, and would be very acceptable to ladies and children.

Suggestion re Blackboard, giving results from Judging Rings:

Mr. H. S. Hayes suggested that there should be blackboards placed in a prominent position, where the results from the various judging Rings could be posted for the information of the general public.

Placing of Telephone between Judge's Box and Pocket:

It was also suggested that the telephone between the Judge's Box and the Pocket in the Jumping Enclosure should be placed outside the Judge's Box, and that a man should be put in charge of the phone to send out and to receive messages. These were all referred to the Show Committee.

Inspection of Works at Grounds by Committee:

The Committee then inspected the various works being carried out in the Show Grounds, also the Judging Rings and the Jumping Enclosure.
