

Re signatures for cheques:

The Secretary stated that, in accordance with the rules of the Society, all drafts for payments and disbursements shall be signed by the President or Chairman at the General Committee Meetings, the Honorary Secretary and the Secretary, except for weekly wages and petty expenses a draft for which shall be signed by the President or Honorary Secretary, or a member of the Finance Committee and the Secretary.

Through the death of the late Mr. A.H. Moore, there is now no Hon. Secretary, and the rules of the Society do not provide for the election of a Hon. Secretary except at the Annual General Meeting of the members, which will not take place until Jan'y. 1951, but, in order to enable us to issue the cheques, it will be necessary for us to give written authority to the Bank that two signatures only be now necessary, viz:- those of the President, or presiding Chairman, and the Secretary.
