Re Box Stalls:

Regarding the proposal of the Show Committee to convert the existing Standing Stalls in the North Hall at the Show Grounds into Box Stalls, suggestions were invited from members of the Committee as to what would be the most suitable size of Box Stall to erect. The sizes of the existing Box Stalls in the Show Grounds varied from 12' x 12' to 11' x 8'. It was pointed out to the Committee that the most suitable size for alignment with the existing buildings of the Society would be 12' x 9', as whatever type of Box is erected, certain structural alterations would have to be made in the main supports of the roof, but the latter size (12' x 9') would be the most suitable and economical from the Society's point of view. After further discussion, it was agreed to recommend to the Show Committee that this type of Box Stall would be very suitable.

Re providing towels for Judges in Sheep Section:

Mr. J.B. Barter raised the question of providing towels for the Judges in the Sheep section, and the Secretary pointed out that these were to be had at the offices of the Society at the Show Grounds on application, which Mr. Barter said he was unaware of.
