Jumping Competitions:

Arising out of the Minutes of the Show Committee Mr. Desmond B. L. suggested that a Consolation Jumping Competition should be put on instead of a Novice Competition, and to debar the prize winners of the previous competitions from entering in this competition. After some discussion, the matter was referred back to the Show Committee.

Show Committee:

The Minutes of the last Meeting were read and signed.

Correspondence:

A letter was read from Mr. D. Twomey, 51, Landsdowne Rd, Balisbridge, Dublin, agreeing to act as Judge in Shorthorn and Dairy Cattle Sections at the forthcoming Show. A letter was read from Messrs W. F. Poole & Co Ltd., Westland Row, Dublin, protesting against the starting day of the Show on a Monday, as this adds considerably to the expenses of any exhibitor going to Cork Show from Dublin. They also stated, that they feel if in the future, this policy of the Committee was adhered to the number of exhibitors would tend to drop off. A letter was also read from the Cork Iron & Hardware Co., North Main St, Cork, looking for extra space at the Summer Show, and for permission to erect a flue on the Stand for demonstration purposes, to be built with concrete blocks, and also to put in a small overhead tank and cylinder to provide hot water, for use in their stand. This matter was referred to the Sub Committee.

Jumping Competitions:

With regard to the recommendation from the General Committee to include a Consolation Jumping Competition instead of the Novice Competition at the forthcoming Show. The Committee decided to put on a Jumping Competition, and to debar the first and second prize winners in the previous competitions at this Show from entering in this competition. They further decided to make the Children's Jumping Competition, on the last day of the Show, a Champion Competition, prizes to be- first .£10. second £ 4. third £2. and to increase the entry fee to 10/-.

Member co-opted to Sub Committee:

It was decided to co-opt Mr T. O'Leary, Springmount, Carrigrohane, to the Sub Committee.
