

- (1) Sheep should be shown on the year in which the show is held and given to be given to the judges to use their discretion to disqualify sheep not having show.
- (2) That Suffolk and Ryedale Ewe Sheep should have a separate classIFICATION.
- (3) An English Judge should be appointed to judge Flock Ram Inter.

A request was received from the Irish Herdwick Breeders' Association that exhibitors can send in animals onto the grounds at the Spring Show.

In the motion of Mr. Sean Murphy seconded by Mr. H. S. Holton a vote of appreciation was passed to Mr. G. B. Tracy on running the Elementary Jumping Competition, and to Mr. J. S. Ford on running the Championship for Herds at the summer show.
