

- (1) Sheep should be shown in the year in which the show is held and none to be given to the judges for use their discretion to designate sheep not properly shown.
- (2) That Suffolk and Oxford Horn Sheep should have a separate classification.
- (3) An English Judge should be appointed to judge Texan cattle.

A request was received from the Irish Haystack Breeding Association that exhibitors' cars should be allowed into the grounds at the Spring Show.

On the motion of Mr. Sean Murphy seconded by Mr. M. S. Heyford a vote of appreciation was passed to Mr. J. B. Casey on presenting the Exemplary Jumping Competition, and to Mr. J. F. S. Sward on winning the Exemplary for Horses at the Summer Show.
