The Minutes of the previous Meeting, having been read, were approved and signed.

Correspondence:
Reception of entries from Accredited Herds:

A letter, received from the Steward to the Duchess of Westminster, asking what arrangements were being made for the reception of entries from Accredited Herds for the Summer Show, was read. After a discussion, it was decided to allot a number of Box Stalls at the northern end of the Cattle Shed for entries of this value, and to contact the Department, and ask to have these inspected, with a view to ensuring that they would meet the requirements laid down.

Erection & Placing of Farm Kitchen:

Advertising to a letter received from the Cork Federation of the Irish Countrywomen's Association, read to Finance Meeting of 15.3.58, the Secretary informed the Meeting that he had contacted the E.S.B., and asked to have their representative (Mr. Ennis) present at the Meeting on that date, to explain the position regarding the erection of the FARM KITCHEN at the Show Grounds. As this gentleman was in London, and would not be available until 30.3.58, the Secretary was asked to contact him on his return, and convey the Society's views to him regarding the erection and placing of the Kitchen.

Re Advertisement for Irish Hereford Breeders' Assoc:

A communication, received from the Irish Hereford Breeders' Association, offering a sum of £7 towards the Summer Show prize money, was read. As a condition of the offer was that a full page advertisement should be inserted in the catalogue free of charge, it was decided to inform the Association that, as this advertisement would cost the Society the sum of £8.7.6, the offer of prize money, in such circumstances, would not be of much benefit to the Society.

Re Novelty attraction for Summer Show:

The Secretary announced that he had written several Agencies in England to try and obtain a suitable Novelty attraction for the Summer Show.

List of Prizes:

The list of prizes for 1958 was considered, and, after examination in detail, the following alterations made -
Jumping Competition A - the prize money to read as follows - 1st prize - £25; 2nd prize - £10; 3rd prize - £5; 4th prize - £2.

It was also decided that, where there were eight or more entries in the Cattle classes, a fourth prize of £1 would be awarded, except where otherwise stated.

The Secretary was asked to write the Royal Dublin Society and ascertain if they could suggest classes for Landrace Pigs.
