Secretary read statement of Shon accounts

Read letter from Messrs Tower & de la Pierre stating that they could not get permission from Dublin Castle to bring their Cattle into the Country & consequently they were unable to Shon them & asking that their fee may be returned which after some discussion it was decided to do

Read letter from Mr Murray stating that the race Committee were willing to take £15 as the society share for renewing the paddock paling which it was decided to give

Read letter from Mr Hungerford objecting to Lord Linstow's Bull having been admitted to the Shon yard after 6 o'clock after considering the matter the Committee decided that under the rules the Secretary had power to admit the Cattle

A considerable discussion ensued as to the advisability of erecting a permanent Shon yard when on the motion of Mr Ferguson it was decided to recommend the general Committee to appoint a deputation to wait on the Corporation with reference to obtaining a portion of the Park
