

3. Exhibitors & stallholders will be provided with tickets differing in color but numbered consecutively as with numbers, to be shown on entrance his holders to sign their names in book in the books provided & to enter at numbers gate
To obtain readmittance it will be necessary to show the ticket & sign the book as before
4. Visitors will obtain tickets from the ticket office at the entrances, each ticket having the price of purpose for which issued printed on it. Tickets of same price to be numbered consecutively & colored differently for adults & children
Visitors will thus enter at the turnstile & hand ticket to the attendant who on releasing the machine will drop ticket into a well cover box provided for the purpose & placement top of the turnstile
5. Seafors tickets may be purchased as before or at ticket offices, the holders will claim them & will pass thru the gate provided for members will sign their names in book in the members books
6. Tickets for the Veterinary Padcock will be obtained at the ticket office at jumping enclosure & given to gallman at entrance to Padcock who will drop into box at other entrances
