

Meeting of Show Committee held Saturday April 2<sup>nd</sup>

Present Mr W Roberts in the chair, <sup>Mr Geo Holtkush</sup> Messrs L A Beamish  
 Abj Warren, J. King, G. Beard.

The minutes of last meeting were read and signed.

It was agreed to cancel the engagement of a judge of Kerry cattle as there were only two entries in each class from the same exhibitor.

Mr J. A. Forrest wrote stating that owing to illness he would be unable to judge Dutton and it was decided to appoint Mr H. J. Nicker Blackrock as judge.

A letter was received from the National Sheep Breeders Association suggesting that all sheep exhibited should be registered <sup>entered on the list of</sup> in the Black Book of the breed and on the motion of Mr Beamish seconded by Mr Warren it was decided to adopt this suggestion.

It was further agreed to frame a rule prohibiting the colouring of sheep exhibited at Summer Show.

Mr Beamish mentioned that Mr Sherman Crawford and Mr B. J. Durlong <sup>would</sup> each contribute £5 towards prizes in the three year old gelding class and it was decided to allot the prizes as follows in this class -  
 1st prize £30: 2nd prize £10: 3rd prize £5: 4<sup>th</sup> prize £3:  
 5<sup>th</sup> prize £2.

It was decided to circulate <sup>general</sup> a leaflet giving details of the prizes for 3yr old gelding and 2yr old stallions.
