On the motion of Col Heard seconded by Mr J W Keolles it was decided to extend the time for closing of entries until 20th June on single fees all entries to close on that day no double fees

Read post card from Mr J Reali requesting that his cattle be received after the arrival of the 8 p.m. train from Fermanagh on the motion of Mr L A Beamesh seconded by Mr Jason Bird Mr Reali's request was acceded to

Mr A J Forster applied for permission for Mr R Townsend to exhibit ^{all} incubators at show which was granted

Read letter from Messrs W J Shaw & Sons stating that they would exhibit specimens of suitable & non suitable pigs at the show

It was proposed by Mr L A Beamesh & seconded by Mr G Forfit that the show be open on the evening of the first day from 7 till 9 p.m. & passed unanimously

The question of having a second stand for the horse pumping was considered & after some discussion the Secretary was instructed to write to Messrs Flynn & ascertain what addition they would make to the first stand for the £20 paid them for the second stand last year
