

Meeting of Show Committee held  
Thursday April 13<sup>th</sup> 1905.

The minutes of last meeting were read and signed.

Mr Seamesh mentioned that Mr R. J. Borden had suggested to him to change the dates of the Summer Show to July 7<sup>th</sup> + 8<sup>th</sup> on condition that the Ulster Society would change their show to the last week in June. After a discussion it was eventually decided to ask Mr Borden to make the proposal to the Ulster Society.

With reference to Mr O'Sullivan's objection to Mr Stanley's exhibit no 111 at Spring Show it was decided to write to Mr Stanley cautioning him to be more careful in making entries in future.

It was decided to withhold second prize in classes 29 & 35 on the ground that these exhibits had also been entered in the Dairy Section contrary to rule.
