Green Fodder.

Each Exhibitor requiring soiling, can obtain order at the Secretary's Office for bundles of 7 lb. weight at a cost of 1/- per bundle. The money to be returned to the Exhibitor at the end of the Show.

The forage contract to be paid at a price to be agreed on, on presenting the order issued from Secretary's Office.

No forage to be issued between 10. a.m. to 6. p.m.

Straw free

Straw will be issued, to all animals in the yard in the following quantities viz

14 lb. for each horse or neat Cattle

10 lb. for each pen of sheep or pigs

these quantities to last for first two days

Half these quantities may be issued on the 3rd day if considered necessary by the senior Steward of the class. -

The forage contractor will supply hay at a fixed price to be posted in the yard
