Tenders for 76 yards of corrugated iron Hoarding were read & it was decided to refer back to the tenderers the Hoarding for fresh quotations the Hoarding to be erected in 22 gauge iron in a similar manner to the Hoarding erected at the south side of Kilmory Paddock.
