Read letter from Mr R U P Fitzgerald's steward requesting that ~~his~~ Mr Fitzgerald's Dexter Bull calf be admitted to the Show for exhibition not for competition there being no class for Dexter Bulls his request was acceded to on the motion of Col Heard seconded by Mr Barker

Read letter from Mr Stone ^{stating} that he had not as yet been able to procure judges for horses or shortwooled sheep & that he had only succeeded in getting one judge for short horns after some discussion it was decided that Mr Wiley should be asked to judge short horns as well as dairy cattle

Read letters from Great Southern & Western & Cork & Brandon Railways stating that they had made arrangements for special trains for the day of the show

Mr Ferguson informed the committee that Mr Leach was willing to provide Breakfast & Luncheon on the same terms as last year, but that he would not undertake the 1st class bar the secretary was therefore instructed to apply for tenders for same

Mr J J Mahony waited on the committee & informed them that Mr Delany was willing to take £25 for his 5 team styles after some discussion Mr Mahony was empowered to give him £22 10/-

Mr James Byrne was appointed Judge of Machinery
On the motion of Mr Meade seconded by Col Heard Mr Love was appointed Superintendent of the Yard remuneration to be the same as last year & he was ^{to be instructed} ~~however~~ to provide ^{the} fodder for the show
