

Meeting of Show Committee held Saturday  
April 29th

Present messrs. G. L. Steadman the chair Messrs

The minutes of last meeting were read  
and signed.

Mr. J. J. Jurlong attended and stated he had  
been asked by the owners of Cahernie Fair to inquire  
if the Society would be prepared in future to hold  
the Summer Show on the Tuesday and Wednesday of the  
second week in July on condition that Cahernie Fair  
would be held on the succeeding Thursday and Friday.  
The committee unanimously approved of the proposal  
subject to the further approval of the General Committee.  
The matter was referred to the General Committee.

Mr. Breed Blyne attended and urged the  
committee to appoint two judges in each horse ring,  
to provide better veterinary accommodation and to  
arrange jumping competitions so as to debar previous  
winners of competitions. After a discussion  
it was decided to appoint two judges for No. 1 Ring. The  
other requests of Mr. Breed were also acceded to.

Capt. Jetherstonhaugh wrote accepting the  
invitation to judge young horses

Mr. Jno. Stanley wrote protesting against  
withholding second prizes in classes 29 & 35. It  
was decided to adhere to the previous ruling.
