

Meeting of Show Committee held Saturday Jan 14, 1905

Present Messrs: W Roberts in the chair Messrs: La Beemish, S. Dering, Abj. Warren, Major O'Connor, S. L. Beard, and J. O'Sullivan.

The minutes of last meeting were read and signed.

Mr J. O'Sullivan mentioned that Messrs Mack & Sons would offer a Challenge Cup for competition at the Spring Show and it was decided to recommend that the Cup be given for the best yearling shorthorn bull.

A letter was read from the Bacon Cures Assn. offering £12 in prizes and requesting that £3 be allocated as first prize in a new class for two fat pigs. It was decided that as prizes were already offered for this class, to ask the Bacon Meats to apply their prizes as last year.

It was decided to allow exhibitors in the Tenant Farmer classes to compete in the open classes where eligible.

Mr R. Broad wrote offering to judge poultry at a fee of five guineas inclusive of expenses.

Mr R. Stratton wrote regretting his inability to attend to judge shorthorns and it was decided to invite Mr Chas. Overley, the first shorthorn to judge in his stead.

It was decided to exclude poulterers from competing in classes for dead table poultry.

Major Focke wrote accepting invitation to judge knobbed stallions and jumping.
