Luckey enquiring 1 as to lights of arts & ponies at Summer Show 2. as to whether the Show Committee would require arts & ponies like shown in the my under saddle & 3 as to why the Society had ceased to be affiliated to the Polo Pony Society. These questions were referred back to the Show Committee.
