The question of appointing a caretaker for the Show Yard was then under consideration where after considerable discussion it was decided on the motion of M^r W H Beamish sec^r by L A Beamish to refer the matter to the Directors

Read letter from the secretary of the Munster Dairy School mentioning that M^r John Morrison Knockalister had been appointed member of the committee

Read letter from the Irish Kennel Association forwarding a resolution that had been adopted by the Association to the effect that a written guarantee should be given by ^{the owners} all dogs competing at the show that they had not been in contact with dogs suffering from distemper or mange. the matter was referred to the dogs Show Committee

M^r Stoker announced that he had been informed by some members of the Cork town Council that it was very probable that the Society could get a room in the municipal buildings in which to hold their meetings and that an office could be procured in Queen street for £10 per annum that would meet the Secretary, after considerable discussion the Committee adjourned to inspect the offices on the ground floor of 18 Warrens Place, and dispersed without arriving at any conclusion
