Read letter from the Irish Kennel Association forwarding a resolution that had been adopted by the Association to the effect that a written guarantee should be given by ^{the owners} all dogs competing at the Show that they had not been in contract with with dogs suffering from distemper or mange. the matter was referred to the dog Show Committee

Mr Stoker announced that he had been informed by some members of the Carrigrohane town Council that it was very probable that the Society could get a room in the municipal buildings in which to hold their meetings and that an office could be procured in Queen Street for £10 per an that would suit the Secretary, after considerable discussion the Committee adjourned to inspect the offices on the ground floor of 18 Warrens Place, and dispersed without arriving at any conclusion
