

Meeting of Show Committee held Thursday
July 27th 1904

Mr W Roberts in the chair also present Mr P. Dwyer

Letters were read from Messrs M. A. R. Becher, J. G. Ryall, J. B. Donworth objecting to the award of three prizes to Mr John Flannery's brood mare "Lady Lydenham" in three different classes as this was contrary to rule. It was decided to allow the awards in classes 1 and two remain and to cancel award in class 3

It was to cancel the Reserve award in class 3 to Mr John O'Sullivan's brood mare; this exhibit having received ^{second} ~~third~~ prize in class 18.

Applications for refund of entry fees were received from Messrs A. Harris, R. Dolan & J. O'Brien, all of which were rejected.

Mr J. J. McQuinn objected to the award of first prize to Mr R. Nash's dog no 19 on the ground that the dog was not registered in the exhibitor's name in the Kennel Club. It was decided to communicate with Mr Nash on the matter.

The Rev. J. Reed wrote claiming 10% being the amount of his expenses incurred in sending dog to show and which was not shown in the judging ring; and which he alleged Mr Burke had guaranteed to have shown for him. It was decided to refer the matter to Mr Burke.

It was agreed to withhold prizes in sheep classes where there were less than three different exhibitors in each class according to rule.
