In connection with a complaint made by Mr. Scott Kerr concerning the appointment of a judge of sheep he dog at recent show Mr. Woods handed in a cutting from "Our Dog" showing that a dog named M. Lass, <sup>now owned by Mrs. Scott Kerr</sup> was exhibited at the Blackburn Show April 25 1903, by Mrs. Crossfield ~~and~~ obtained first prize. It was decided to communicate these particulars to Mr. Scott Kerr.

A letter was read from Dr. W. Davy applying for payment of 30/- amt of first prize in a class for Scottish Terrier which was divided into sexes at the show. It was decided that as Dr. Davy was one of the guarantors and that as no sanction was obtained from the committee, the arrangement being made between the exhibitors and the judge only, to refuse the application.
