

Meeting of Show Committee held Saturday  
12<sup>th</sup> Augt 1905.

Mr. G. L. Hard in the Chair - Also present  
Major O'Connor, Messrs. L. A. Beamish & W. E. Burke.

The Minutes of last Meeting were read &  
Signed -

A letter was read from Mr. D. P. Hawkes re  
objection to Sheep exhibited by him at our recent Show,  
stating that he intended taking no further steps in  
matter until he heard that Committee would withhold  
Prizes - It was decided to write Mr. Hawkes that  
unless Committee had satisfactory proof that  
Sheep were eligible for entry in Hock Book of  
the Border Leicester Sheep Breeders Society, on or  
before 1<sup>st</sup> Sept. next, they would then proceed to  
distribute Prizes to parties next entitled in order of merit.

A letter was read from Mr. P. P. Hogan asking  
to have two fines of 5/- each permitted - It was decided  
to make enquiries of Stewards, who imposed fines, with reference  
thereto -

A letter was read from Mr. A. B. Charlton Secy Hunter's  
Improvement Socy that he had sent on Gold Medal to Mr. Gordon,  
the Silver Medal for best Filly to Mr. J. O'Connell & the Silver Medal  
for best Hunter entire yearling Colt to Mr. Painbridge; ~~but~~ that the  
other 2 Medals awarded to Mr. Callaghan & Mr. Buckley had  
not been sent as they had not complied with Conditions, and  
as a Month had elapsed since the Show, the reserves in each  
Case are now entitled to the awards but as the reserve to Mr.  
Buckley's gelding was Mr. Callaghan's winner under Scheme D, this  
award would fall to the ground & asking to have Veterinary  
Certificate of horse No. 273, sent him - It was decided to  
send Certificate as requested.

It was decided that Major O'Connor & Mr. Q. A. Beamish  
should draw up separate Reports as to the best means to adopt  
to keep better check on gate receipts, & submit same  
to Committee -
