Ireland declining the request of the Society
for a grant of £20 towards prizes.

The following resolution was proposed by
Mr. G. Logan and seconded by Mr. Ferguson -
That having heard with deep regret the refusal
of the Congested Districts Board to assist our
scheme, though we were led to believe from
their letter of last year, that we might count
on their co-operation; we are compelled from
want of funds, to restrict the prizes to four
Unions, and we decide to select those of
Bantry, Schull, Kinsale and Clonakilty.

lists printed for each Union and distributed
among those most likely to forward the
scheme.
