

Meeting of Show Committee held Thursday
17th August 1905.

Mr. G. L. Heard in the Chair. also
present Major O'Connor, Messrs. L. A. Beavril

D. Hall.

The minutes of last meeting were read
and signed.

With reference to letter received from Mr.
W. Donovan enquiring as to why his horse "Silverspring"
was not allowed take part in Jumping Competitions
on second day of show, it was decided that the
Steward (Mr. Penier) should be consulted with reference
to Open Competition and that 10/- Entry fee ^{for Ribbon class} should
be returned, as his horse had won a Second Prize the
first day of show & consequently was not entitled to compete.

The Prize list for the forthcoming Fruit,
Grain & Root Show was drafted. It was
decided to write to the donors of Special
Prizes last year enquiring if they would renew
the Prizes. It was also decided to engage
Assembly Room for 4 days - 11th, 12th, 13th & 14th Oct. -
for the sum of £12.
