The minutes of last meeting were read & signed

It was decided to write to the Admiral informing him the place to land His Excellency would be at the stage where His Majesty the King landed and that the Society would have refreshments for their Excellencies

It was decided to ask Messrs C. Allen Dublin & B. P. J. Mahony Maryboro to act as V. S. to act as V. Surgeons at Summer Show & Mr G. Phelan to act as Referee

It was decided that the charges of admission to show yard & jumping enclosure should be the same as last year <sup>(with the exception of)</sup> the charge to the jumping enclosure being raised to 2/6 on the second day.

Major O'Connell proposed & Mr S. Hall seconded that the charge of admission to the Grand Stand on the second day be raised from 1/6 to 2/6.

Mr W. McDonald seconded by Mr W. E. Burke moved as an amendment that the seats on the Grand Stand be reserved & numbered and that a charge of 5/6 per seat be made

The amendment was carried by a majority of 8 to 4

It was decided to charge 5/6 per seat if taken on or before July 2<sup>nd</sup>

It was decided to order new badges for show the colors to be the same

Mr Frank Coffey attended to ask the committee to move a resolution condemning the actions of the Government in allowing the terms of the Army meat contracts from Home bred to Home killed

It was decided to refer this matter to the General Committee
