With reference to a bill of costs amounting to £3.17.0
furnished by Mrs J. DeBington for services in connection

it was decided to decline payment as the Society was not
liable.

It was decided to apply to the Down Green Assn.
the Little Trade Assn. and Mr O'Neill Belfast to renew
their special prize as last year.

The prize list of the Spring Show was revised and
the following alterations in last year's list were made:-
new class Short horns - for the best ^{yearling} Bull having served as
a Premium Bull in Co. Cork in 1904. Prizes £5. £3. £2

It was decided to provide a new class in Aberdeen Angus
for Bulls calved prior to Jan 1. 1903 and to give a first prize of £5
if Mr. Hum Bland would give a second prize of £3.

new class (open) Dairy Cattle, for the best & low average bred over
bred in calf or in milk by £5. £2. No prize unless 4 entries
A new class for yearling heifers by £4 & £2 was included
for tenant farmers only.

It was decided to cancel any class for store cattle where
there were not four entries.
