The minutes of the half year meeting were read & signed

A letter was read from Mr C. J. Furlong expressing the hope that the Show Committee's recommendations would be passed

The following recommendations of the Show Committee were unanimously adopted

- A. That saddle horses be shown on both days of the show.
- B. That young horses & brood mares be exhibited only on 2nd day of the show
- C. That horses sheep & dogs be allowed in on each day of the show up to 10.30 AM all to be ready for judging at that hour ~~with horses going by both~~
- D. That prices of admissions be as follows
 Season tickets 5/- each
 1st day up to 2 p.m. 3/- from 2 p.m. 2/- jumping each 2/- 1/-
 2nd day 1/- admission to showyard, jumping each 1/- 1/6

E. On the motion of Mr W. Roberts seconded by Mr A. A. Beattie the following recommendation was carried by a majority of 26 votes to 6
 That horses going by boat or train may be allowed out at 4 p.m. on the 2nd day of the show on application to the Secretary from whom passes must be obtained
