J. Henderson Steward + D. R. Lack Buresford.  
objected to John Bird getting 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize in  
Class 91 Long Red or yellow Mangel as globe yellows  
are not eligible for this class. this objection  
was overruled.

Fitz W. A. Scott objected to the decision of  
the Judge in disqualifying his Exhibit in Class 37  
owing to his having staged *Griseoignes Scarlet* as a  
Cocker, this objection was also overruled.

A letter was read from the Department  
of Agriculture asking for dates of Spring  
Shows for 1906. it was decided to bring it  
before the next meeting of the General Committee

A letter was read from the G. S. & W. R. stating  
that two Indemnity forms enclosed were not  
signed by the Exhibitor, or his agent + consequently  
were of no use to the Exhibitor. it was decided  
to get the forms signed + given to Railway Co. if they  
would accept them then

a letter was read from Mrs Johnnie Cartletown rocks  
stating that she had to pay carriage 1/6 on food returned  
from Show while our Schedule stated that all Exhibits  
be taken back free. it was decided to refund same
