The following resolution was adopted on the  
motion of Mr. S. Frick seconded by Mr. Howard.

That while approving in the main of  
the objects of the proposed Agricultural Union  
as drafted by Lord Winchelsea we are of  
opinion that it is not practicable for the  
Lore Agricultural Society to take any  
active steps to carry out the proposed  
scheme without interfering with its own  
special functions as an Agricultural Society.

Seconded by Captain Newham. and resolved.

That in as much as we were led to believe  
that the outcome of the Railway Commission  
would be to reduce the rates we are more  
than surprised to find on the contrary that  
the rates are increased, and that at a time  
when agriculture and trade are in a most  
depressed condition. We earnestly trust that  
the Railway Companies will see their way to  
reduce their charges to the old rates at least  
and that copies of this resolution be sent to  
the Board of Trade, and the Railway Board.

The Secretary was also directed to send copies  
to the members of Parliament for Lore, and to  
Messrs Morley and Balfour.
