A letter was read from Mr Wm Lydall re Mr Fitz W. A. Scott's objection
to the disqualification of an exhibit at recent fruit show, Mr Lydall
deciding against the objections

It was decided to send Mr Fitz W. A. Scott a copy of Mr Lydall's
letter.

A notice was read from the Irish Hunter's Register office offering
champion silver medal for best riding pony stallion and champion
silver medal for best Thoroughbred stallion serving Hunter mares in
the district during 1906 at a fee of £5. or less

~~A letter was read from the Cork Athletic grounds Coy. asking for gate
to be left at jumping enclosure to be left open on week days during practice
hours and undertaking that their caretaker would have charge of the gate~~

~~It was decided to allow the gate to be opened subject to the district
understanding that this permission may be cancelled at any time and
without assigning any reason~~

It was decided to get fresh levels laid at the jumping ground

The revision of Spring Show schedule for 1906 was concluded, the following
two classes having been added

Class no 6 To pure bred bull calved between 1st August & 31 December '04

13 For best family group of three pure bred Shorthorn cattle either
entered in or eligible for Cattle Herd Book, the group to consist of
a cow ^{or heifer} in milk and two other animals either her produce or from
her dam or g. dam butlocks excluded

1st prize in this class £7-0-0 presented by Mr L. A. Deamick

59 For best Home made soda bread made from Irish flour confined
to bona fide labourers

60 For best Home made bread made from Irish flour confined
to farmers £50 + under

1st prize in this class presented by Mr L. A. Cantillon
