A notice was read from the Irish Hunter Registry office offering
champion silver medal for best Riding pony stallions and champion
silver medal for Best Thoroughbred Stallions serving Hunter mares in
the District during 1906 at a fee of £5- or less

~~A letter was read from the Cork Athletic Grounds Co. asking for gate
to be left at jumping enclosure to be left open on week days during practice
hours and understanding that their caretaker would take charge of the gate~~

~~It was decided to allow the gate to be opened subject to the district
understanding that this permission may be cancelled at any time and
without assigning any reason~~

It was decided to get fresh levels laid at the jumping ground

59 For best Home made soda bread made from Irish flour confined
to bona fide labourers

60 For best Home made bread made from Irish flour confined
to farmers £50 & under

15th prize in this class presented by Mr L.A. Cantillon
