The secretary announced that he had been washed on by the Society for prevention of cruelty to animals, who offered to give £3 in prizes for Donkey at the coming show provided the Society £2, the offer was refused but the secretary was directed to ~~the~~ inform the society that if they wished to give prizes for Donkey, the exhibits would be admitted into the yard

The consideration of the Prize list for Horses was then taken up when the following alterations were made in last year's programme, a prize of £10 was added for the best 4 year old filly in Class C sections 1 + 2 in Class C Section 4 two year olds the first prize was increased to £15 Class C Section 5 first prize increased to £15, a prize of £10 was added for the best Horse or mare driven in Harness (to be reduced to £5 unless 5 compete) Class D Section 1 ponies first prize increased to £8 Section 2 increase to £5 the word Cob was added to Section 4 Class F, ^{Section 2} Brood mares prizes increased to £15, £6, £4 Section 2 first prize increased to £10 to be reduced to £5 unless 9 compete it was also decided that all Brood mares except prize winner could leave the show the first day except the prize winners Class G for Hackney Horse Hairs was struck out Jumping prizes, it was decided to have 3 jumps on each day i.e. Water, Stone wall + Sturdle the prizes the first day to be £20 + £6 the second day £15, £5, + £1 winner of the first prize on the first day to be excluded from competing the second day
