

Meeting of Show Committee

In G. L. Head in the chair also present were L. A. Beauchesne W. E. Burke

 & Major O'Connor.

The minutes of last meeting were read and signed.

A letter was read from Mr W. J. Harken Cornwall stating he would judge
 dairy cattle or Shorthorn at spring show.

A letter was read from Dr. L. A. Scott & asking for replies to some questions
 re his disqualification of his exhibit at recent fruit show. The Secretary
 was instructed to reply to the questions put.

A letter was read from the Secretary of the West Industrial Development
 Association stating that Circulars from the Canadian Govt. Law have
 distributed by farmers in the district stating that the matter has now to be
 brought to the Society's notice to have such distribution discontinued
 also requesting that no space be allowed at future shows to emigration
 agents.

On the motion of Mr L. A. Beauchesne seconded by Mr Burke it was
 decided to inform the Secretary of the C. I. D. Assn. that circulars
 had been issued to any one in the district that ordinary advertisements
 would be accepted and that space if applied for would be accepted in the
 usual way.

A letter was read from Major Chavasse supporting such a cattle
 auction to be held during the spring show on the ground.

Mr Hatch was asked to attend and after considerable discussion it
 was decided that Messrs Hatch & Son would be auctioneers at 12 noon on
 2nd day of spring show.

A charge of 5% auction fee to be charged by auctioneers to buyers
 & a refund of 2½% to the meet to the society by the auctioneers.
